



## A Beautiful Story of Wang Ya

I just received call from Wang Ya, who just arrived in Shanghai, after three years of hard work for TLBU Global System in USA. (She visits her parents for three weeks).

Wang Ya came to TLBU in September 2008, and she cared classmates and school as a general coordinator, just like He Bo in the class of Entering Year 2012.

After Master Degree, she studied LLM Program of George Washington University Law School from August 2010 –May 2011. During her study at GWU, she began to take responsible of financial management of TLBU Foundation in Washington DC area. Despite her heavy burden, she passed New York Bar Exam in 2011 (attended bar exam in July 2011, and the result was published in November 2011). Among 6 TLBU graduates who studied at GWU in 2010-11, she alone passed bar exam after the preparation of less than 3 months, and quite good score, even though she should work for financial operation of TLBU Foundation.

After bar exam, she dedicated herself totally for the sale project of TLBU Property in Maryland (The Michael Company took charge main responsibility of the sale, but she should participate as a coordinator representing President LYOU for TLBU Foundation, and participated in the various process of the contract and the settlement for 9

months). And at the same time she did main role for purchase of TLBU Foundation building in Maryland and Oh St Joseph Resort Hotel in NJ for more than one year. Since we chose two properties among more than 20 candidate properties, she had visited Virginia, Maryland, Washington DC, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, New York State. With very limited driving ability, she travelled so frequently more than 20 times large area of South Korea.

After the purchase of bankrupted hotel from an auction, to normalize this troubled hotel, she worked 365 days per year without even one single day off! During the Weekend and holidays she has been much more busy, since during weekend and holidays several hundred people stayed at hotel, and in the Convention Center (inside tennis courts) and several party halls, several hundred people celebrated banquets overnight with noisy music and dancing.... As she concentrated too much for the hotel work, she missed the opportunity for working visa application in time, and for the solution of temporary visa issue, she was obliged to study at community college at evening time for accounting. Her dedicated work was so heavy, even cruel, that excepting sleeping time, she should spend whole day for hotel work.... From time to time complaining guests disturbed even her peaceful sleep!

Now our hotel should be best hotel among neighbor hotels. And for last one year she supported more than \$300K for TLBU in Seoul, in Paris and students in Seoul...

Yesterday I accompanied her to Kennedy Airport, remembering that she


